Summary Statement

Adam R. Grose is a Tutor, Artist and Writer with a wide range of experience teaching GCSE, A Level, Postgraduate, Adult Education, Special Education Needs, Art Groups and Workshops. His artistic practice investigates dynamic sets of layered, diaphanous, repeating patterns of line, tone, colour, form and rhythm: layering as a metaphor for archaeological time and exploring the physical engagement we have with reality.

Grose's work often combines scientific methods using collected material from the landscape, extracting and growing soil bacteria. He uses these as the basis for his reduction and monotype prints, using handmade printing ink and paint from local rocks, exploring mark making through hand burnishing and other printmaking/ painting techniques.
